B. Revised Proposition

BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of Education hereby authorizes that a proposition be submitted to the voters of the Peekskill City School District at the annual school district meeting, to be held on Tuesday, May 19, 2015, which shall read as follows: BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Education shall be authorized to embark upon an energy savings capital project with an energy service company selected by the District, including District-wide: lighting replacements; natural gas conversions for heating system(s); replacement of steam boiler(s); installation of condensing boiler(s); replacement of windows and doors; convert heating from electric to gas; installation of gas fired rooftop units; roof upgrades including insulation and coating; variable frequency drives for air handling units; asbestos abatement associated with said energy conservation measures; and, other appropriate energy conservation measures as authorized by Article 9 of the Energy Law and the Regulations of the Commissioner of Education §155.20, at an estimated cost of \$4,892,707 to be financed pursuant to law in anticipation of the realization of energy cost savings over the term of an energy performance contract resulting in no cost to the School District.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Board of Education hereby authorizes the District Clerk to publish the text of this proposition in the legal notice for the May 19, 2015 annual school district meeting.
